safeTALK Training for Trainers (T4T) https://bit.ly/2lu3uFs	5/21/18 and 5/22/18 8:00 – 5:30pm *FREE but space is limited	The safeTALK T4T is a two day course that prepares candidates to become safeTALK trainers. safeTALK is a half-day training in suicide alertness. It helps participants recognize a person with thoughts of suicide and connect them with resources who can help them in choosing to live. Participants don't need any formal preparation to attend the training - anyone who wants to make a difference can learn the safeTALK steps. Per Living Works guidelines, trainer candidates must complete three workshops in their first year to become a registered trainer.
