	 Mr. Daniel Besseck, Howard County Fire and Rescue, shared highlights from the Falls Prevention Pilot conducted in Parkview Colonial Landing: Success: Department of Community Resources and Services gave a presentation on falls risks and mitigation to 25 residents Engagement rates reached 40% during project period In total 4 advanced directives were completed Challenges: The area with the highest positive screening, advanced directives, had a low engagement rate Food security provided a low need yet time intensive area Next Steps: The screening tool will need to be refined based on real world experiences Service offerings that include other healthcare needs such as vision and hearing may be valuable fall risk
